TUITION PAYMENTS:

Tuition payments will be managed by Children's Academy @ Loch Haven. Registration Fee and weekly tuition payments can be made by phone, payment on site with credit card or check, and/or Tuition Express (electronic payment system)

REGISTRATION:

- Summer Camp only registration is \$65 per camper. Registration fee is for the entire summer, regardless of actual days attended and includes (1) camp t-shirt per camper.
- Registration Packets must be completed along with registration fee for confirmation of summer camp enrollment.
- Registration fees are non-refundable.

Special Promotion: Year-round school-age registration fee of \$122 is available if you would like to use CALH for school days out during the upcoming school year and includes your summer camp registration.
