Infants

A & B... Hello parents! Spring is in the air and in our classroom too. April is going to be a fun month for us. Our theme is Easter and we will be making fun Easter artwork.

Our infants are continuing to grow and develop their skills through exercise, learning activities, music and playtime. The babies really enjoy story time and songs.

We are so excited to welcome our new friends, Benny, Brooks, Elliott, Jasmine and Madison, to our class. Happy Easter!

Toddlers

A... In April we are going to learn all about Easter, Spring, Life Cycles and Earth Day. Please wear pastel colors on Friday, April 2 as we celebrate Easter weekend.

Toddlers

B... April's theme is "Easter Bunny". We'll be teaching shapes, colors and numbers.

Week 1: We will work on the color pink and use circle shapes to make a bunny.

Week 2: We will use oval shapes to make Easter eggs in the colors purple, white, yellow and blue.

Week 3: We will be using yellow circles to make chicks.

Week 4: We will be creating Easter baskets from paper bags and decorating them with purple, white, yellow and blue paint.

Twos

2A... Welcome to Spring! This month our class will explore simple science. We will be planting lima beans and doing experiments with water and ice.

Week 1: What's in the ground?

Week 2: How do we use the ground?

Week 3: Seeds, sun, water, and ground!

Week 4: The results are in!

We will be working on name recognition and numbers 1-10. We will continue to focus on and have discussions about being safe in various weather conditions.

2B... This month we are going to introduce the topics: Spring, Easter and Earth/Earth day.

We are going to concentrate on spring and pastel colors: blue, green, yellow, and pink.

We will be introducing shapes: circle, square and triangle.

Please make sure to keep weather appropriate change of clothes for students in their cubbies. Two changes of clothes for non-potty trainers and at least 5 for potty trainers, including underwear.

We are asking that students bring in a backpack, at least every Friday, to take home their artwork for the week. Thank you.



Threes

Bible Curriculum: God made everything. (Genesis 1:1)

This month children will learn to associate God with things of His creation and explore what God has made.

Lesson Theme:

Week 1: Easter - Children will learn about Good Friday, Easter stories and have discussions.

Week 2: Clouds, plants, seed and flowers - we will be making a cloud art project. We'll talk about stratus, cumulus and cirrus clouds.

Week 3: Earth Day - all week long we will be learning everything about Earth day.

Week 4: Going around the world.

We will be working on the letter Nn, the number 18, the color brown and the rectangle.

Parents please remember to read with your kids daily and ask them questions.

Fours

4A... For the month of April we will be talking about cultures of the world. Students will be learning about different culture aspects like location, language and food. They will learn how we are different, but still the same. Parents please talk to your children about the different cultures that are a part of your family.

The Bible stories this month will be about the footsteps of Jesus. We will talk about all different places Jesus visited and how He demonstrated the importance of unity.

For Spanish class students will learn the names of different foods in Spanish.

Happy Birthday to Penelope and Isabella, we will be celebrating their birthdays this month.

4B... This month is a continuation of what we were learning in March, Seasons All Around.

During our circle time we sing nursery rhymes, recite months of the year, and the days of the week.

We also work on sign language. Students have learned to sign the days of the week, daily words like yes, no, wait, water, sorry and restroom.
